### **Emory College Semester Study Abroad Program - Credit and Grade Translation Memo**

Program: University of Amsterdam (UvA) (Amsterdam, Netherlands)

When studying abroad, students should be aware that their host institution's or program provider's credit and grading systems may differ from Emory's. The information contained in this memo is correct to the best of Emory College Education Abroad's knowledge as of the date posted above. This memo has been created using information provided by the study abroad program, in consultation with colleagues at other institutions utilizing the same study abroad program, and/or per guidelines or commonly used practices in the field of international education and education abroad. Students should also be aware that changes are possible at any time and should contact Emory College Education Abroad for clarification if any questions or concerns about course enrollment expectations or grading arise.

## **COURSE APPROVAL PROCESS**

Students must obtain approval for ALL courses taken abroad and must consult with the appropriate departmental Faculty Study Abroad representative at Emory for course approvals that are **NOT** already blanket approved. Students may **NOT** take classes for which they cannot obtain approval. The Office of International and Summer Programs (OISP) will not process a study abroad transcript until approvals for ALL courses have been received.

### **CREDIT TRANSLATION**

The University of Amsterdam (UvA) uses the ECTS credit system. **Emory will transfer credits from UvA at a ratio of 2 ECTS to 1 Emory credit** (divide the number of ECTS by 2 and round to the nearest whole credit).

Students are required to take the equivalent of <u>at least 15 Emory credits</u> per semester. A full semester course load at UvA is at least 30 ECTS (15 Emory credits) per semester. Most UvA courses are worth 6 or 12 ECTS credits; a full semester course load at UvA is typically 5 courses worth 6 ECTS each. Example of credit translation:

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Emory students can choose to take an *optional* Dutch language course through the Institute for Dutch Language Education (INTT / NT2 Academy) as part of their total course load. The Emory equivalent for this course is LING 151.
