

Emory College Study Abroad **Fall/Academic Year 2021 Programs**

Emory College Study Abroad is still accepting applications for the below Fall and Academic Year 2021 study abroad programs through March 15, 2021.

Please keep the following information in mind as you explore program options and begin the application process.

Though we plan to work with students on their applications over the next few months, the health and safety of our students continues to be our number one priority. Some or all opportunities may be suspended with little warning due to the impacts of COVID-19. Final decisions about whether international programs will be permitted will be made at the highest levels of Emory University leadership. [Study abroad advisors](#) are available to address further concerns and questions.

Applicants for fall/academic year study abroad should:

- Have a good back-up plan (Emory courses) and try to maintain flexibility (with classes, housing, etc.).
- Be cautious about financial commitments that are non-refundable (visas, housing, flights, etc.). Make sure to read your host institution or program provider's policies regarding costs and refunds carefully.
- Monitor [International SOS](#) alerts, the [U.S. Department of State Travel Advisories](#), and the [CDC Travel Health Notices](#) for information about COVID or other safety/security issues in their intended host country and the [Emory Forward website](#) for important Emory community announcements.

For all Fall/Academic Year 2021 study abroad programs, Emory College Study Abroad will refund the \$75 application fee for any student who decides to voluntarily withdraw up to the day before their program's official published arrival date; additionally, no student will lose their \$300 program deposit. If Emory decides to cancel your program at any point, you will be refunded the \$75 application fee, and you will not lose your \$300 program deposit.
